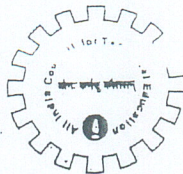

Sub: Extension of AICTE approval to Siva Sivani Institute of
Management, Kompally, Secundrabad, Andhra Pradesh.

Sir,

I am directed to state that based on the recommendations of an Expert Committee of the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), the AICTE has accorded extension of approval to the Siva Sivani Institute of Management at Kompally, Secunderabad under the aegis of Siva Sivani Education Society, Secundrabad for conduct of P.G. Diploma in Business Administration with an annual intake of 40 (forty) during the academic years 1993-94 and 1994-95 only.

This approval is subject to fulfilment of the following conditions :

- 1) The conditions laid down vide this council's letter No.F.40-2/92-AICTE dated 9.12.1992 remain unchanged.
- 2) The Management of the College including the Governing Council should be constituted as per the guidelines of the AICTE.
- 3) All admissions should be made as per the norms and guidelines of the AICTE and as adopted by the State Government of Andhra Pradesh.
- 4) The tuition and other fees should be charged as prescribed by the State Government within the overall criteria prescribed by the AICTE from time to time. No capitation fees should be charged from the students/guardians of the students in any form.
- 5) The accounts of the Institute should be audited by a Chartered Accountant and should be open for inspection by the AICTE or anybody authorised by it.
- 6) The teaching and other staff should be recruited according to the procedure, guidelines and experience prescribed by the AICTE.
